

ANGLING TO RESUME ON WEDNESDAY MAY 13th

On Sunday 10th May, the Prime Minister announced the resumption of unlimited outdoor sports, including angling, provided that anglers fish alone (or with members of the same household) AND THAT SOCIAL DISTANCING RULES ARE FOLLOWED AT ALL TIMES.

He also made it clear that it was now permissible to drive in order to take part in these activities.

Accordingly, Permit Holders at Cogra Moss will be able to resume fishing from Wednesday May 13th.

All the normal conditions of permit will apply and in addition all anglers will be expected to follow social distancing rules e.g. to maintain at least 2 metres apart at all times.

Anglers are also expected to respect other users of Cogra Moss and again follow social distancing rules.
